We will, in collaboration with governments and our stakeholders, **MAINTAIN TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY** in reporting methane management performance. We will work to improve how we share existing methane management information.



We will **SUPPORT PUBLIC POLICY** aimed at pragmatic, targeted and achievable reductions in methane emissions intensity from producing operations.
