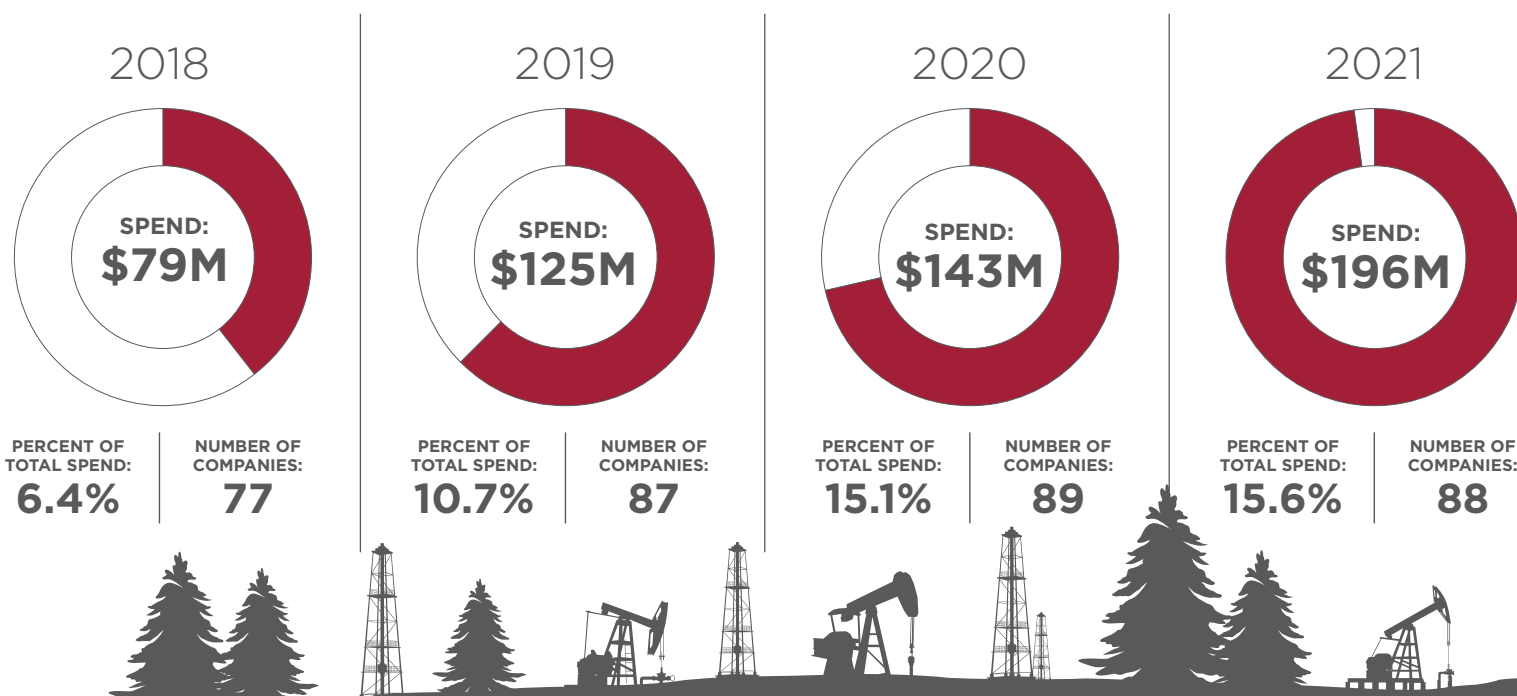
A study by iTotem Analytics found strong connections between Indigenous-affiliated businesses and the B.C. natural gas supply chain.

## SPEND WITH INDIGENOUS-AFFILIATED BUSINESSES (2018-2021)



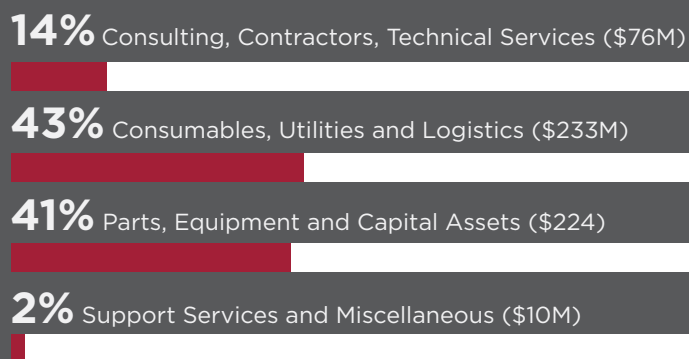
## INCREASING SPEND

A wide range of Indigenous-affiliated companies and entrepreneurs were involved in providing goods and services to B.C.'s natural gas and oil industry, including land reclamation, drilling, engineering, equipment maintenance, construction, camp services and more.



## DID YOU KNOW?

From 2018 to 2021, B.C.'s natural gas and oil industry invested **\$13.6 million** to support more than 75 Indigenous-affiliated community initiatives and organizations.
