## Crude Equalization Scale Change

Effective with February 2015 production, the Equalization Steering Committee is retaining the current equalization scale. The equalization scale penalty factors are calculated by one member of the Equalization Steering Committee and independently verified by no fewer than two additional members of the Committee. The calculated information is consistent with and based on the existing approved procedures.
